Description of Project in Detail

“Vaccination is a crucial step towards the eradication of COVID-19 Disease.”

After months of research on Medicines and Viruses, India finally started vaccinating people in January 2021. After the launch of the vaccine, social media and other platforms flooded with fake rumours about the vaccine which raised a question mark in the minds of common people which resulted in a decreased rate of vaccination countrywide especially in Nagpur. Seeing the above situation Rotaract

Club of Priyadarshini College of Engineering, Nagpur collaborated with Nagpur Municipal Corporation, Rotaract Club of Nagpur and "Together We Can" to tackle the situation. Rotaractors had a cluster of meetings with the administration of Nagpur Municipal Corporation and members of other organizations to make a blueprint of the vaccine awareness project.

Volunteers from all over Nagpur were chosen to go out on the field and help people to register themselves online for vaccines and book slots for vaccination at a nearby hospital. The duty of vaccine awareness was also given to the volunteers. Volunteers were divided zone wise reporting to the ZMOs of the respective zones. Some volunteers deployed to the vaccination centres to help the medical staff of the hospital while others were told to visit door to door to the people and help them to register for vaccination. A bus was also provided by NMC to each team who were working on field to take the people from their homes to vaccination centres and vice versa. In this way, the great plan of the project successfully came into action with the help of dedicated volunteers who were working selflessly and only for the wellness of the society. This project came to an end for some of the volunteers after 20 days but some of the teams are still working on the ground to make people come out of their houses for vaccination.

The dedication and confidence of volunteers was surely more than the heat and fervency of the sun as they helped more than 10000 people to get vaccinated in the above mentioned period. This project couldn't have been a great success without the help and guidance DRR Abhishek Goyal (RID 3030). Description of Project in Detail

“A community is like a ship, everyone ought to be prepared to take the helm.”

As India battles the second wave of COVID-19 and situation of Nagpur getting worst, and the health care system buckled under its weight racing against time to save lives, social media got flooded with messages asking for help to get hospital beds, ventilators, Remdesivir, plasma, and other essentials for Covid-19 treatment. Rotaract Club OF Priyadarshini College of Engineering, Nagpur came up with project “KIRAN” to help and do as much as they could for those in need.

After looking at people desperately asking for help on social media platforms, Rotaract Club of PCE realized the shocking condition we immediately started to reply to as many people as possible. We felt this was not enough because lots of needy were still being missed and needed more engagement. As we had so many contacts, we had to contribute by connecting and for this we, KIRAN came into play with a group of project directors and team. Flyers, videos and all the plan to provide help was ready in few hours. Whatsapp numbers and calling numbers of rotaractors namely Gaurav Chauhan, Himanshu Tripathi, Shubhankar Mishra, Prachi Yerojwar, Abhishek Kumar Pratik Sahare respectively for services information on Oxygen Cylinders, Vaccination Centres, Testing Centres, Home Remedies, Respiratory equipment, asymptomatic consultation, plasma donation were provided. We got several messages and calls in a day and still receiving it. Rotaractors started working for whole day and also in nights to serve the community. Videos on the use of oximeter, proper wearing of a mask, etc, were also released to avoid unnecessary visits and monitor yourself effectively and get to the hospital at right time. Team members try their level best and work hard to manage to do justice to all the requests from people. Till date we have been able to manage 50+ beds as per the demand. O2 cylinder and all other requisites had also been met.

We got many messages from people thanking and appreciating us for the help they received and the work we are doing. Many of them were our teachers and their families that we could serve. In tough times we see leaders stepping up and serve in the best way possible and helping in saving lives. After getting such acknowledgment "Thank you you saved our near ones life" it such a blessing to hear this. The whole team is putting in their best efforts, looking forward to catering more people, and is really blessed and grateful to part of this amazing family

Description of Project in Detail

“ Ultimately, the greatest lesson that COVID-19 can teach humanity is that, we all are in this together.”

How can not the deadly surge of the pandemic make rotaractors restless? Looking at the current scenario wherein people are finding it very difficult to get a bed available in the hospitals, not even being checked up by some of the doctors, scarce of medical facilities and medications. Rotaract Club Of Priyadarshini College Of Engineering Nagpur, Rotaract Club Of Nagpur Vision under the banner of Nagpur Municipal Corporation (NMC) and Together We Can cordially took an initiative to help the citizens of Nagpur to cope up with this pandemic situation which is getting worse day by day. To handle these circumstances responsibly the initiative was led by Rtr. Sanaiel Ahmed (Rotaract Club of Nagpur Vision) and Rtr. Mohammad Zafir

(Rotaract Club Of PCE). NMC and other non -profit organizations of Nagpur came together and brainstormed how the hike in the death rate could be brought under control in Nagpur. Finally, they found a solution that NMC would be joining hands with all the organizations to activate more hospitals and covidcare centres for the needy people. In this regard,a detailed survey was taken over by our rotaractors followed by various meetings with the Commissioner and Mayor of the city and people from other organizations. After all the hustle, they found a hospital named Panchpaoli Maternity Hospital available with 110 vacant beds which were not under any use. With permission and support of hospital authority and local administration, the campaign to activate the hospital for COVID patients had finally begun. To make this initiative a success, many other organizations such as “Together We Can”, “Dawate-e-Ismali Hind Nagpur” and “Asra Foundation Nagpur” came together for this noble cause to save Nagpur from this deadly situation. On analyzing the whole scenario NMC agreed to grant permission for 50 beds for suffering patients. Oxygen and monitoring requirement was met in few days. All the healthcare staff was also arranged by our Rotaractors and were ready to serve the people with the help of local administration and ZMO of the concerned zone. As the situation was getting worst day by day NMC suggested making up all the necessities as soon as possible and thereby activate all the 110 available beds. After pondering over the expected shortage of oxygen cylinders we came up with the idea of starting the Liquid Oxygen Plant for meeting the oxygen requirement. And this plant will come into action in the next 7-8 days. In this way, Panchpaoli Maternity Hospital is totally ready with necessities such as oxygen beds, medical staff, and medicines required to treat covid patients which will surely be helpful to curb the devastating situation. In the coming days, we are planning to make available ventilator beds and we are sure to make up with that too.

As we know other Rotaract clubs of Nagpur also also working really hard and to support the society Rotaract Club of PCE and Rotaract Club of Nagpur Vision Came up with the idea and executed it in these hard times. These project and only possible with the help, guidance and support of our DRR Abhishek Goyal (RID 3030). Even after being at risk of getting infected our dedicated Rotaractors are working day and night to provide humanitarian services and serve the community in all possible ways.
